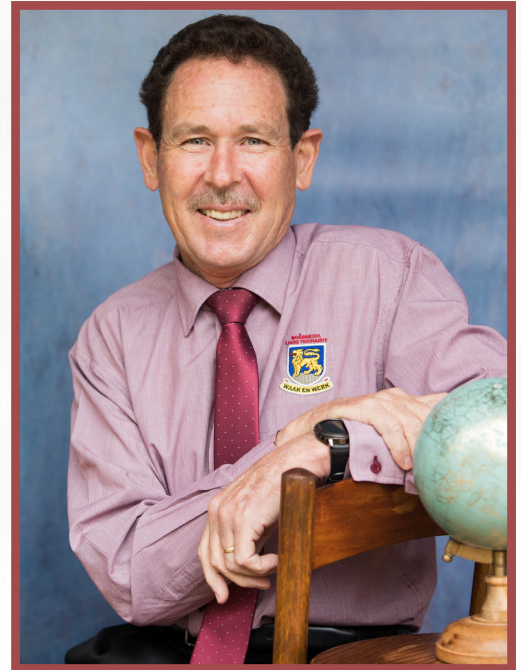
Involvement builds a positive feeling of unity. Involved Triegies spend more time at school than at home. This is healthy because here we learn together.

Please note that Hoërskool Louis Trichardt still supplies our learners with free scripts. If a script is full or lost, it is your responsibility to replace the script.

SCHOOL UNIFORM:

Refer to the school diary that every learner will receive in January 2023. All rules regarding your child's appearance are stipulated there.

The school uniform and sportswear are available at our own Triegie shop at school. Please take note that it will be compulsory to wear the school blazer for all the grade 8's every Monday and Friday.

Boys: Khaki pants, khaki shirt, grey school socks and school shoes.



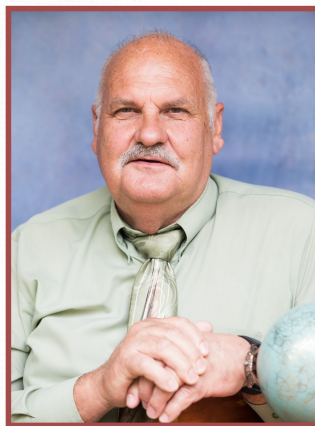
ABSENTEEISM:

Please be advised that only the parent/guardian is allowed to personally sign the learner out at the school office. Parents must pre-arrange to sign out your child by using the relevant documents available in the day planner that your child will receive.

Learners will only be permitted to leave the school grounds in the presence of their parents/guardians. We ask the parents to only sign learners out during school hours in extreme cases of emergency, as they lose valuable tuition time.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS MUST BE MARKED WITH YOUR NAME.

A. MUST BRING LIST

1. Sleeping bag & Pillow or duvet (+ 1 light blanket)
